## ORDINANCE NUMBER 8.08(3)

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTION 8.08(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF RANDALL, KENOSHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 8.08(3) of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin is amended to read as follows:

## "(3) Fee and Deposit Required

An applicant shall pay a fee of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) with the permit application and further before any permit shall issue from the Town for any excavation on a per cut basis in any road, sidewalk, alley or public ground shall be granted, the applicant shall also deposit with the Town Clerk a compliance bond in the amount of not less than One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) to insure proper replacement of the pavement or other surface after completion of the work. In the event the Town Public Works Committee estimates restoration costs greater than One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00), the bond required shall be in an amount equal to 110% of the estimated restoration costs. In the event there is no damage to the pavement or other surface or less damage than the amount of the bond, after a twelve (12) month period, the bond shall be released in the amount exceeding the cost of damages."

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
