
Calling All Residents to Participate in Well Water Testing Spring '26

Things to Know:

- **Town Recycling Center** is cheaper than using a Waste Management Company. Cost is \$4/bag of garbage, and free for Recycling. Recycling Center Hours (until Labor Day): Saturday 8am-2pm & Tuesday 6pm-8pm.
- **Cut back brush to allow for emergency vehicles.** Your driveway must be a minimum of 14' tall and have 6' clearance to each side of driveway.
- **Luke Bryan Farm Tour Concert** will happen on September 18, 2025 at Klondike Farms on Highway 92.

Free Sharps Containers from Green County Public Health

1. **Pick up a Sharps Container** from Green County Public Health, N3152 WI-81, Monroe, WI 53566.
2. **Dispose of Sharps.** Dispose of needles and lancets in the container.
3. **Return it.** Return it to Green County Public Health to be disposed of.
