RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADJUSTMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL LEVY LIMIT FOR INCREASES IN CHARGES ASSESSED BY THE BELLEVILLE, MONTROSE AND EXETER EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the municipal levy limit is allowed for increases in charges assessed by the joint fire and emergency medical services departments organized under Wisconsin Statute 66.0602(3)(h) for each governing body served by the joint departments, and

WHEREAS, the allowable adjustment is as follows:

The percentage increase in the total charges assessed by the joint fire and emergency medical services departments for the current year relative to the total charges assessed by the joint departments for the previous year, must be less than or equal to the Consumer Price Index for urban customers, U.S. City average, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the preceding 12 months ending on August 31 in the year of the levy, plus two percent.

WHEREAS, each governing body served by the joint departments must adopt a resolution in favor of the increase in charges;

WHEREAS, the Town of Brooklyn is a governing body served by the Belleville, Montrose and Exeter Emergency Medical Services District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Brooklyn, Green County, Wisconsin, approves an adjustment may be added to the tax levy limit for increases in charges for <u>EMS services</u> assessed by the Belleville, Montrose and Exeter Emergency Medical Services District, as determined above for the 2025 tax levy.
