Resolution for Dane County Ward Creation and Designation of Polling Place

WHEREAS, the Brooklyn Village Board, County of Dane, Wisconsin, is responsible for ward creation in the Village of Brooklyn.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Brooklyn Village Board, Dane County, Wisconsin, that the Village of Brooklyn will be three wards as indicated on the attached map, also described as follows:

Ward 1: All of the territory within the boundaries of the Village of Brooklyn and within the County of Dane west of N. Rutland Avenue.

Ward 1 description by Census Tract and Block Number:

Part of Tract 12400, Blocks: 1045-1049

Ward 3: All of the territory within the boundaries of the Village of Brooklyn and within the County of Dane in TID District No. 2.

Ward 3 description by Census Tract and Block Number:

Part of Tract 12400, Blocks: 2073, 2075, 2080, and 2099

Ward 4: All of the territory within the boundaries of the Village of Brooklyn and within the County of Dane east of Rutland Avenue to the western boundary of TID District No. 2.

Ward 4 description by Census Tract and Block Number:

Part of Tract 12400, Blocks: 2074, 2081, 2083-2090

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Brooklyn Village Board, Dane County, Wisconsin, that the Brooklyn Village Hall, 102 North Rutland Avenue, Brooklyn, Wisconsin, be designated as the polling place for all voters in Wards 1, 3 and 4 in the Village of Brooklyn.
