

CHAPTER 32 – TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

Sec. 32-48. Zoned and posted speed limits.

- (1) State Highway 92:
 - a. Twenty-five miles per hour from its intersection with Union Road (West Main Street) through Commercial Street;
 - b. Twenty-five miles per hour beginning at Church Street to the village eastern boundary;
 - c. The speed limit on all other portions of State Highway 92 within the corporate limits of the village shall be as posted.

Sec. 32-50. Operating of vehicles on public property.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to operate any motorcycle, motor bike, mini-bike, trail bike, ATV, or other similar motorized vehicle in or upon any portion of public land, including, but not limited to, parks, parkways, or open space easements, unless designated as a park drive, roadway, parking area or temporary parking area within such public land, without prior approval of the village board.
- (b) It is prohibited to operate a motor vehicle as listed above in such a manner as to cause damage or destruction to the park land, facilities or parking areas.
- (c) Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$500 plus damages, per the village fee schedule.

Sec. 32-51. Operating of snow removal vehicles on public streets.

- (13) For a violation of this section, a person shall be subject to a penalty as listed in the schedule of fees and penalties.

Sec. 32-85. Posted limitations.

- (c) The law enforcement officer is hereby granted the authority, within the reasonable exercise of police power to prohibit, limit the time or otherwise restrict the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles beyond the provisions of chapter 346. The public works department shall have the authority to restrict the turning or movement of heavy traffic and to impose special weight limitations on any highway or portions thereof which, because of the weakness of the roadbed due to deterioration or climatic conditions or other special or temporary conditions, would likely be seriously damaged or destroyed in the absence of any restrictions on heavy traffic movement or special weight limitations.
