The caucus date for the Town of Forest has been set for Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at the Forest Town Hall at 12931 State Highway 56 East, Viola. Offices to be filled in the Town of Forest are Chairman, two Supervisors, Clerk and Treasurer.

The caucus is a method often used by towns and villages for nominating candidates to be placed on the Spring Election ballot. Although the caucus is open to the public, only qualified electors of the Town of Forest may nominate and vote for candidates.

A person is not required to be a registered voter in order to participate in the caucus. Any person who is a United States citizen, 18 years of age or older, who has resided within the municipality for at least 10 days before the caucus is a qualified elector.

An individual who interested in office does not necessarily have to attend the caucus, but should notify the clerk or chairperson that he or she would like to be nominated.

Only those persons nominated will be voted on at the caucus, if voting is necessary.
