**2025 Tax Reminders** - Tax payments can be made in person at the **Brown County** Treasurer's Office located at 305 East Walnut Street, Room 160, Green Bay: Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. & Fridays 7:30 am – 11:00 a.m. or online at www.browncountywi.gov/propertytax.



Please note: Dog license fees cannot be included in your tax payment – please direct payments with the completed application to Michelle Wallerius, Treasurer at 5993 W. Cherney Road, Denmark. An application is attached or can be requested from the Treasurer and/or is available online at the Town website under the Form section.

**Dog Licenses:** Pursuant to Wisconsin statutes, all dogs over 5 months of age must be licensed. Fees for SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS are \$10.00, otherwise the license is \$15.00. You will need to furnish the dog's name, sex, breed, whether it is spayed or neutered and the date and type of last **Rabies Vaccination** when applying for a license. A completed application and payment should be mailed to the Town Treasurer, Michelle Wallerius.

**Town Board Actions:** The following are **only highlights** of actions & discussions at the monthly Town Bd meetings. Official Minutes can be found online at <a href="https://www.townofnewdenmarkwi.gov">www.townofnewdenmarkwi.gov</a> or by contacting the Clerk.

#### August 2025

- \*Info Permit for Winnekens home addition. Shoreland permit approved for R. Kane Lane.
- \*Assessor Gaworek working on yearly maintenance. Sales are strong with preliminary equalized value up 12% from 2024. Completed Assessor II certification.
- \*Town section of Kvitek Rd torn up and to be resurfaced. Pine Grove by Beverly Gardens, N. Cherney and Pepper chipped sealed. Ditches cleaned out on Maribel and issue with culvert on west side. Culvert collar to be added at R. Kane Lane and additional rip rap. Review of bids for Peterson Lane. Section owned by Village and roadbed to be built up to allow for drainage. Bridge at Steves Cheese Rd to be addressed, currently posted for no trucks. Discussion of adding ordinance that Town needs to be notified prior to land spreading to ensure proper roadways are being utilized.
- \*Sup. Goetsch recommends adding Brad Rymer as alternate to Plan Commission to replace Francis Rabas. Experience with surveying and zoning. Motion to appoint Brad Rymer to Plan Commission.
- \*Sup. Calewarts would recommend Town utilize half-percent sales tax for road improvement projects in 2025.
- \*Zoning Administrator Hafs addressed CSM with Village for ND-330 and Town approves with clarification as to wetland delineation. Review of ND-373-2. Parcel created 3/12/1980 buildable with 20 acres. Review County ordinance to determine required road frontage. \*Comprehensive Plan meeting with Village of Denmark 8/26/25.

#### September 2025

- \*Sup. Goetsch attended Brown Cty Planning. Southern bridge project moving forward and ahead of schedule.
- \*Info permit for ND-743 24x24 garage. MC ND-440-1 for addition to shop. MC Discussion of landowners adding material to right of way to expand or create new driveways without permit. Zoning Administrator to send letter to property owners to comply with required driveway/culvert permit.
- \*Village of Denmark inquires if Town would like to participate in Intergovernmental Agreement ss they work on Smart Growth Planning. Town to nominate Keith Brunner, Dave Schlies as Plan Commission representatives, Bill Hafs and Michelle Wallerius to attend future Smart Growth meetings with Village.
- \*Fire numbers installed at Hidden Hills Lane. Kvitek, Pepper and Cherney Rds paved. Crushed blacktop added to Peterson Lane and Neshota Lane. Culvert blockage addressed on Maribel Rd.
- \*Town to contract with Brown County Sheriff's Dept to patrol town roadways 4-6 hours per month. High traveled roadways include Cooperstown, Rosecrans, Kvitek and Pine Grove to monitor speed. \*Denmark Red Lighting to utilize Town Hall third Tuesday of the month. Sup. Calewarts to coordinate.
- \* ND-373-2 frontage requirement is 500 feet. Recommendation to submit non-conforming use application and refer to Plan Comm. \*ND-347-1 Raze order for 5409 Steves Cheese Road based report of building inspector.
- \*Town meeting set for 10/2/25. 2026 budget meeting 10/20/25. \*Motion to transfer \$80,385.08 from half-percent sales tax to
- \*Motion to transfer \$80,385.08 from half-percent sales tax t Highway fund to cover 2025 road improvement projects.

### October 2025

- \* Discontinuation of Old Settlers Rd (ND-239-2). Atty. Sickel to double check this is recorded with Brown County Register of Deeds. \*Info permit for ND-394 for addition to BelGioioso Cheese factory. Dual zoning. Need to address zoning and demo of existing home. Refer to Plan Commission. Request from Spectrum to add fiber optics in right of way. MC
- \*MOU with County Clerk for Wis Vote Relier services for 2026-27. Cost is .60 cents per voter. Clerk provides half the reporting services for absentee requests and maintenance. MC
- \*Administrator Hafs submitted Brown Cty Natural Hazard Mitigation survey for Town.
- \*Review of Brown County Joint Municipal Court operation agreement. Approved by Town. MC
- \* Discussion of creating ordinance to address 24 hr notification for land spreading. Atty. Sickel to look at surrounding community ordinances.
- \*P. Krueger to utilize Town Hall for storage for holiday assistance. Mark Cherney looking for Town representative to participate in the War Memorial Park, does not have to have a military connection.
- \*Sup. Goetsch states Curative Connections will be adding two additional vans to their fleet to assist with transportation needs of elderly or disabled members of Brown County.
- \*Brown County to update zoning map of RS Shops to reflect it was all rezoned to B-1. DNR has open enforcement case regarding filling in right of way / culvert by Langes Corners.
- \*Follow up to Raze Order for ND-347-1 & ND-521-1. CSM for ND-521-1 referred to Plan for rezoning due to frontage. Non-conforming use permit for ND-373-2 and rezone for ND-436 referred to Plan. \*Plan Commission mtg set for 1020/2025 at 7 pm.

## November 2025

- \*Ordinance to require 24 hr notification for land spreading referred to Plan Commission since it is a land use matter.
- \* Info permit for ND-150-1 to demo old shed and replace with 63x106 accessory building. MC Info permit for solar array on roof for ND-694. MC Info permit for 5761 Cooperstown Rd for addition of full bath. MC ND-190 G. Dworak for culvert permit. MC Keith Brunner for new culvert permit. MC
- \*Assessor Gaworek working on maintenance and provides 2025 class and comp ratios. Town fell below 90% and out of compliance. Computer revalue likely needed in 2028-29. *Stats available online under November meeting info.*
- \*2026 Town Budget adopted. Mtg of Electors approved levy & highway aids.
- \*Revised recycling ordinance approved with new guidelines. MC
- \*Damage to Wanek & Rosecrans guardrails. Tires picked up.
- \* Fire Dept would like town to have on hand road barricades for future road closures. R. Finnel offers what he has available. \*Order to Raze for ND-329 attached to property/new property
- owner. Report from NLC for land spreading. Residents to provide letter of approval if spreading within 500 feet of residence. Adm Hafs to follow up. Rezone for ND-521-1 approved for 4.63 acres Ag-R. Non-conforming use permit due to road frontage on ND-373-2 approved. Rezoning for ND-394 approved to L-1, with demo permit and conditional use for temporary residence to be used by Rabbi. MC
- Rezone for ND-436 to B-1 tabled due to County question as to mound size and Village of Denmark approval.
