To the Citizens of Steuben

The selectboard is pleased to submit this annual report for the year 2025. Overall, the business of town government has remained steady despite the economy and the challenges of availability of supplies needed to finish a project. Our focus continues to be providing essential services while maintaining fiscal responsibility. Revenue primarily comes from taxes and we continue to look for ways to diversify income to ease the burden of local taxpayers.

This year the board worked diligently to stay within our 2025 budget. We managed to get some much needed ditching done on a few roads in town that had been put on the back burner while we took care of storm damage in 2024. We will be starting the Rogers Point road work in May to repair some of the damage done during the January 2024 storm.

We are pleased to report to the residents of Steuben that our County TAN payment was \$ less than we were originally quoted, which in turn makes our yearly Bond payment \$34,524.32, our first payment is due January 15, 2027.


