ORDINANCE 71

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF SANCTUARY, TEXAS FOR THE 2011-2012 FISCAL YEAR; APPORTIONING SUCH LEVY FOR SPECIFIC USES; PROVIDING FOR A STATEMENT REQUIRED BY SECTION 26.05(B) OF THE PROPERTY TAX CODE; AND PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

WHEREAS, it is determined that the current requirements of the budget of the City of Sanctuary, Texas are not supportable at the current rate of income, and the addition of an ad valorem property tax is the only proper means to provide additional necessary funding.

SECTION 1.

There is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of, and by, the city government of the City of Sanctuary, Texas for the 2011-2012 fiscal year, upon all property, real, personal, and mixed, within the corporate limits of said City subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.15 on each \$100.00 valuation of property, said tax so being levied for the purposes of maintenance and support of the city government.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEARS TAX RATE.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000.00 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$150.00.

SECTION 2.

Taxes levied under this Ordinance shall be due 1 October 2011 and, if not paid on or before 31 January 2012, shall immediately become delinquent.

SECTION 3.

The City will make appropriate arrangements with the Parker County Tax Assessor/Collector to administer and collect the tax. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed,

and the Parker County Tax Assessor/Collector shall fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property for the payment of such taxes, penalty and interest.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and publication. And it is so ordained. The City Secretary is hereby directed to provide a correct and certified copy of this ordinance to Larry Hammonds, Chief Appraiser, Parker County Appraisal District.
