

**CITY OF SANCTUARY  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 17  
POLICE DEPARTMENT**

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF MARSHALL OF THE CITY OF SANCTUARY, TEXAS AND PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION AND APPOINTMENT OF A CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY, ALONG WITH SUCH ASSISTANTS AS DEEMED NECESSARY. ALL RIGHTS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FORMER OFFICE OF MARSHALL ARE TRANSFERRED TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**I**

As provided under Article 999a. of the Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, the office of Marshal for the City is dispensed with and all duties conferred on the office of Chief of Police for the City, with full jurisdiction as provided for in Article 998, The Civil Statutes of the State of Texas.

**II**


The City Council shall be authorized to appoint and hire a Police Chief upon such conditions, and such reimbursement as they deem appropriate. In keeping with the same, the City Council may select and hire such assistants to the Police Chief as deemed necessary.

**III**


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.


