

**CITY OF SANCTUARY**

**ORDINANCE NO. 26  
ELECTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE  
TOWN OF SANCTUARY, TEXAS, THAT THE 6 MAY 2000  
REGULAR ELECTION IS HEREBY CANCELED, AND  
UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES ARE ELECTED TO OFFICE.**

**I.**

**WHEREAS**, all candidates in the 6 May 2000 election are unopposed, and as there are no propositions to appear on the ballot, and as the deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration for write-in candidacy have passed, and

**II.**

**WHEREAS**, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 10: 10.24 of the Election code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared elected to office and shall be issued a certificate of election.
