ORDINANCE NUMBER 32

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE CITY OF SANCTUARY AS A TYPE A, GENERAL LAW CITY, AS PROVIDED BY THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUANCE , WITHOUT BREAK , OF ALL ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, LEGAL CONTRACTS, AND APPOINTMENTS IN EXISTENCE AT THE TIME.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SANCTUARY, PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

**I
PREAMBLE**

WHEREAS, the change in designation from a Type B to a Type A General Law City allows for a clarification of the duties and responsibilities of the governing body, and provides an added specificity to those governmental responsibilities and powers necessary to prepare for the growth of the city, and WHEREAS such change is provided for in the Texas Local Government Code, such change has been deemed advantageous by the governing body of the municipality.

**II
DESIGNATION**

Effective upon signature and proper publication of these ordinance, the City of Sanctuary, Parker County, Texas, is designated as a Type A General Law City as covered in the Texas Local Government Code Section 5.001; Section 6.001-6.014, and other pertinent cites.

**III
CONTINUANCE**

All ordinances, resolutions, contracts, appointments and other agreements in effect at the time of passage of this ordinance remain in effect, without break or cessation.

**IV
SEVERABILITY**

If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, or for any reason unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall

not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof or provision or regulation, and to this end, all provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
