Ordinance 04-16-2024

The Town Board of the Town of Mount Pleasant, Green County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, allows for election officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

A. There may be more than one shift for election workers on all election days. Shift hours may vary with availability of election officials and at the discretion of the Town Clerk. Shift hours may be inconsistent among officials and also for each election, provided that there are always at least three election workers staffing at all times throughout each election day.

B. The town board may for each election appoint one additional election inspector to serve as needed at the polling place for the town. This additional election inspector shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process. Hours may vary with availability of election officials and at discretion of the Town Clerk.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
