

Ordinance 1-2019: Accounts Receivable Billing Procedure

Billings by the Town of Mount Pleasant in Green County may be paid within 30 days after the first billing without interest. Thereafter, interest may be charged at the rate of 1.50% per month on billings sent at 60 days and 90 days after the primary billing. Post 90 days, residents and non-residents will be billed as follows:

Residents: Monthly billing will continue and interest @ 1.50% will accrue until the 1st of November of the year. Bills not paid on or before the 1st day of November shall have added to the total amount due 1.50% of said charges and shall be entered on the tax roll as a special charge and become a lien upon real estate.

Non- Residents: After 90 days, bills plus interest will be turned over to a collection agency. Once the bill has gone to collections, the township will no longer accept payment of the bill. All payments will be made to the collection agency.

A \$25.00 charge plus any bank fees will be added to a payment that is returned due to insufficient funds.

A \$1.00 charge will be required for any single copies of township items that are requested by individuals not serving on the town board. An additional \$0.50 will be charged for each additional copy.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, WI stats.
