## Resolution Providing for Placement of Unpaid Delinquent

## Charges on the Real Estate Tax Bill

The Town of Mt. Pleasant, Green Cty., WI hereby establishes the following policy and procedure for the payment of all bills incurred by the Town of Mt. Pleasant. Bills may include, without limitation because of enumeration, weed elimination, mowing, snowplowing, blacktop, culverts, 1st response calls, fire calls (including water charges) and any other miscellaneous charge.

A bill will be sent to the property owner every 30 days by the Town Treasurer and collected. In the event any person owning land in the Town of Mt. Pleasant fails to pay their bill within 60 days will result in interest being charged at the rate of 1 1/2 percent per month from the date of the bill. Those bills remaining outstanding, including interest, for more than 90 days as of November 1 of any year shall become a lien against the real estate and shall be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent special charge pursuant to Section 66.60 of Wisconsin Statutes.
