Resolution 11-11-2025 to Amend MMPW Fire District Bylaws

WHEREAS, the Village of Monticello, the Town of Mount Pleasant and the Town of Washington have contracted with each other pursuant to § 66.0301 Wisconsin Statutes for Monticello Fire and Rescue to provide fire protection and related public safety services for its citizens and properties within jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, each municipality within such MMPW Fire District desires to form a district board and create by-laws for overall guidance and decision-making regarding fire protection and other public safety services which shall be binding upon each of the municipalities within the MMPW Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Mount Pleasant as follows:

- 1. Article 21 of bylaws for the MMPW Fire District shall be amended to read as follows: "The Laws of the State of Wisconsin place the responsibility for inspection on the Monticello Fire Department, and thus, such inspections shall be an obligation of the Monticello Fire Department. As the district does not employ full-time or part-time personnel, fire inspections for the Monticello Fire District will be conducted annually, except for the Monticello School District Facility, which will be inspected twice each year. Fire inspections shall be a part of the budget process for the MMPW Fire District, and the MMPW Fire District shall maintain adequate liability insurance on all persons performing fire inspections. All inspection reports for the properties, both in the Village and the Towns, shall be filed with and maintained by the Fire Department. This amendment is intended to provide clarity and to align our inspection practices with the current personnel resources of the Monticello Fire District while fulfilling our responsibilities under state law."
- 2. Article 25 of the MMPW Fire District bylaws shall be amended to add the following item: "6. After all municipalities approve the amendment and the Fire District Board, the Secretary will add the amended article to the original MMPW Fire District Bylaws, and on the front page of the MMPW Fire District Bylaws, will state the amended date of the MMPW Fire District Bylaws. The previous bylaws will be marked as void to ensure that the amended Bylaws are followed."
