**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR PUBLICATION  
OF THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE DAKOTA COUNTY UNIFORM STREET  
NAMING AND ADDRESSING SYSTEM PROCEDURAL MANUAL  
(ORDINANCE NO. 03-2010)**

**WHEREAS**, on August 12, 2010 the Town Board of Ravenna Township adopted Ordinance No. 03-2010, An Ordinance Adopting the Dakota County Uniform Street Naming and Addressing System Procedural Manual By Reference (“Ordinance”);

**WHEREAS**, the Ordinance adopts by reference the manual adopted by the County to establish a uniform method for naming streets in the County;

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota statute, section 365.125, subdivision 2 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the whole ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, publishing the entire Ordinance is not practicable as it adopts by reference the entire manual and the Ordinance is readily available to the public on the Town’s website.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE DAKOTA COUNTY  
UNIFORM STREET NAMING AND ADDRESSING  
SYSTEM PROCEDURAL MANUAL BY REFERENCE**

The Town Board of Ravenna Township adopted Ordinance No. 03-2010 to adopt by reference the Dakota County Uniform Street Naming and Addressing System Procedural Manual to be used in the naming of the Town’s roads. A copy of the entire Ordinance is posted at the Town Hall, is available at the Dakota County Law Library, the Pleasant Hill Library in Hastings, is on the Town’s website, and can be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk-Treasurer.

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**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to:


- Post a copy of the full Ordinance at the Town Hall;

- Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Pleasant Hill Public Library;
- Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Dakota County Law Library;
- Post a copy of the full Ordinance on the Town's website; and
- Place the ordinance in the Town Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.
