**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE REVISED MISSISSIPPI
RIVER CORRIDOR CRITICAL AREA REGULATIONS AND
APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, the Town Board acted on February 11, 2021 to adopt the updated Ravenna Township Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. 01-2021) (“Zoning Ordinance”);

WHEREAS, the updated Zoning Ordinance contained the Mississippi River Corridor Critical Area regulations required by Minnesota Statutes, section 116G.15 and Minnesota Rules, chapter 6106 (“MRCCA Regulations”);

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (“DNR”) informed the Town that it needed to revise some of the provisions within the adopted MRCCA Regulations;

WHEREAS, the Town prepared the revised MRCCA Regulations as requested by the DNR;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a hearing on the revised MRCCA Regulations on December 9, 2021 and acted to forward them to the Town Board with a recommendation that they be adopted as presented; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to adopt the revised MRCCA Regulations as part of the Zoning Ordinance and to exercise its authority under Minnesota Statutes, section 365.125, subdivision 2 to approve summary language of the ordinance for publication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 04-2021 amending the MRCCA Regulations within the Zoning Ordinance is hereby approved and adopted for the Town.
2. The following summary language is hereby approved for publication in lieu of publishing the entire text of the ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RAVENNA TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE REGARDING THE MRCCA REGULATIONS**

The Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 04-2021 to amend the Ravenna Township Zoning Ordinance to revise the language of the Mississippi River Corridor Critical Area regulations. The amendments reflect the changes requested by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and are intended to satisfy the requirements of Minnesota Rules, chapter 6106. A copy of the ordinance is on the Town’s website and can be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk-Treasurer. The ordinance goes into effect immediately.

3. The Town Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to do each of the following:
- a) Take such steps as may be required to comply with any additional DNR requirements regarding the MRCCA Regulations;
 - b) Incorporate the revised MRCCA regulations into the Town's Zoning Ordinance;
 - c) Publish the approved summary language set out above once in the Town's official newspaper;
 - d) Maintain a copy of the full ordinance in the office of the Town Clerk-Treasurer to make available for review by the public upon request;
 - e) Post a copy of the full ordinance on the Town's website;
 - f) Record a copy of the ordinance in the office of the County Recorder;
 - g) Place a copy of the full ordinance at the Hastings Public Library;
 - h) Place a copy of the full ordinance at the Dakota County Law Library; and
 - i) Place the Ordinance in the Town Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language and a copy of this Resolution.
