**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RE-SIGNING OF THE JOINT POWERS
AGREEMENT BETWEEN RAVENNA TOWNSHIP AND DAKOTA COUNTY FOR
ENFORCEMENT OF LOCAL ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the current Joint Powers Agreement between Ravenna Township and Dakota County for Enforcement of Local Ordinances for January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2021 has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Ravenna Township and Dakota County, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes §§ 436.05 and 471.59, are authorized to enter into an agreement to exercise jointly the governmental powers and functions each has individually; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement enables Ravenna Township to re-secure the services of the Dakota County Sheriff in connection with enforcement of local ordinances adopted by Ravenna Township; and

WHEREAS, Ravenna Township desires to continue the services of the Dakota County Sheriff to investigate violations; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that both parties agree to resign the joint powers agreement; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the joint powers agreement will be signed using DocuSign.

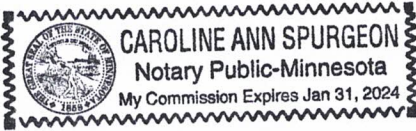


