RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR PUBLICATION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO INCREASE KEEPING OF HORSES

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2024 the Town Board of Ravenna Township adopted Ordinance No. 03-2024 "Ordinance Amending the Ravenna Township Zoning Ordinance to Increase Keeping of Horses" ("Ordinance");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RAVENNA TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE KEEPING OF HORSES

On July 11, 2024, the Town Board adopted Ordinance No. 03-2024 to amend the Ravenna Township Zoning Ordinance to increase the keeping of horses under permitted uses allowed in the Rural Residential District.
