#### **DOG LICENSE FOR 2021**

# Yard Waste Drop Off For Town of Holland Residents Only

The Yard Waste dumpster is located at the south end of the parking lot in the village community park in Hollandtown, and is open from 8 am until 12 pm (noon) on the following Saturdays:

The Appliance Recycle Date for the Town of Holland residents has not yet been scheduled for 2021. Information at a later time.

Accepted yard waste includes, but is not limited to:

Branches - No longer than 3 feet and less than 6" diameter

Hay/straw Garden plants/flowers Brush Leaves Grass Clippings Shrubs

Small brush, yard and garden waste are the **ONLY** items accepted.

Yard waste must be in paper bags or trash cans for dumping.

**NO plastic bags** of any kind will be accepted.

Grass clippings are accepted, however, residents are encouraged to leave the grass clippings on the lawn as a good source of fertilizer.

Items left outside the dumpster after hours will be subject to a \$200 fine per town ordinance. The dumpster is locked outside of collection hours.
