## DOG LICENSE FOR 2021

Residents of the Town of Holland should remember to purchase your dog's license for 2021. Per State Statute, all dogs over 5 months of age are required to be licensed annually. Spayed or neutered dog licenses are \$5 and non-spayed /non-neutered dogs are \$10.

Please send your payment, payable to the Town of Holland, along with a copy of the veterinary information on the dog, as well as information showing rabies vaccination dates and serial numbers, to Gloria Kennedy, 7928 St. Pat's Church Rd. Greenleaf, 54126, and the license will be returned to you via postal service. Forms are also available on the town website.

# Yard Waste Drop Off For Town of Holland Residents Only

The Yard Waste dumpster is located at the south end of the parking lot in the village community park in Hollandtown, and is open from 8 am until 12 pm (noon) on the following Saturdays:

April 17	June 12	August 14	October 2	October 30
May 15	July 17	September 11	October 16	

The Appliance Recycle Date for the Town of Holland residents has not yet been scheduled for 2021. Information at a later time.

Accepted yard waste includes, but is not limited to:

Branches - **No longer than 3 feet and less than 6" diameter**

Hay/straw	Garden plants/flowers	Brush
Leaves	Grass Clippings	Shrubs

Small brush, yard and garden waste are the **ONLY** items accepted.

Yard waste must be in paper bags or trash cans for dumping.

**NO plastic bags** of any kind will be accepted.

Grass clippings are accepted, however, residents are encouraged to leave the grass clippings on the lawn as a good source of fertilizer.

Items left outside the dumpster after hours will be subject to a \$200 fine per town ordinance. The dumpster is locked outside of collection hours.
