Resolution for Moratorium Ordinance

State of Wisconsin: Town of Holland: County of Brown

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town of Holland, Brown County, Wisconsin, does not have any comprehensive ordinance providing guidance and regulation on the development of large scale energy production and storage systems within the Town including but not limited solar energy facilities and battery energy storage systems (BESS) designed to generate commercial scale energy;

WHEREAS, the Town Planning Commission has unanimously recommended that the Town implement a moratorium on the development of such projects within the Town until the Town can create a comprehensive ordinance to provide regulation and guidance for these types of projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town shall consider the adoption of a proposed Moratorium Ordinances for large scale solar energy facilities and BESS facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the governing body of the Town of Holland, Brown County, Wisconsin, determines as follows:

- 1. Proposed Moratorium Ordinances shall be considered for adoption by the Town Board.
- 2. A Public Hearing shall be held at a time place to be set by the Town Board to take public comment on the adoption of the proposed Moratorium Ordinances prior to the adoption of such ordinances.
- 3. Notice of the Public Hearing shall be published a Class 1 Notice pursuant to ch. 985.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
