Adopting Brown County
All Hazards Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the **City/Village/Town** of Holland recognizes that natural hazards pose a threat to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Brown County has adopted the Brown County All Hazard Mitigation Plan as its official plan; and

WHEREAS, the **City/Village/Town** of Holland has reviewed such plan and recommends approval thereof for the **City/Village/Town** of Holland

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the **City Council/Village Board** of Holland, Wisconsin, hereby adopts the 2026 Brown County All Hazards Mitigation Plan, a copy of which is on file with the **City/Village/Town** Clerk, as its official plan and directs that a copy of the same be forwarded to the Brown County Emergency Management Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon approval of the 2026 Brown County All Hazards Mitigation Plan, the Brown County Emergency Management Department will submit the adopted plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval, as required under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
