ORDINANCE NO. 89-

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A USER FEE FOR USE OF THE TOWN OF LIBERTY TOWN HALL

WHEREAS, the Town of Liberty owns a town hall located on English Lake Road in the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the town board deems it in the best interests of the town citizens to make available the town hall for use by public and private groups of persons for uses acceptable to the town board as defined herein; and

WHEREAS, the town board deems its authority to make available the town hall for use by public groups for public purposes at no cost does not extend to making available the town hall to private groups at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the use of the town hall does incur expenses including utilities, clean-up, and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Liberty do ordain as follows:

ARTICLE I. USE OF TOWN HALL

The use of the Town of Liberty Town Hall shall be available to public and private groups. The town board reserves the right to reject the use of the town hall by any group if the purposes for which the town hall would be used are not consistent with the best interests of the township, if the proposed time of use would interfere with use for town purposes, if the user does not have substantial ties to the Town of Liberty, or for any other similar reason in the discretion of the town board.

ARTICLE II. USER FEE

- 2.1 The town board establishes a minimum user fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) for use of the town hall by a private group. The minimum user fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) may be increased in the discretion of the town board, depending on the number of persons in the private group and the length of the event.
- 2.2 The user fee charged shall be paid to the town chairman or designee prior to the commencement of the use by the private group.

ARTICLE III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and posting according to law.
