AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMIT ON WEHAUSEN ROAD

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, finds that based on investigation, the statutory speed limit on a portion of Wehausen Road in the Town of Liberty as further defined in this ordinance is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at that portion of the road; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board declares the necessity to establish a reasonable and safe speed different from that established by Wisconsin Statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its authority under Section 349.11, Wis. Stat., in order to promote public safety and welfare, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. SPEED RESTRICTION. The speed restriction for that part of Wehausen Road extending 1250 feet west of the intersection with Madson Road to 1250 feet east of the intersection of Madson Road shall be 45 miles per hour.

SECTION 2. SIGNS. The Town Chairperson or his designee is authorized and directed to install official signs necessary to effectuate the terms of this ordinance. Such signs shall be in conformity with the Uniform Traffic Sign Manual, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and all other rules and regulations.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. In the event any portion of this ordinance is determined to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares its intent to have passed all other
