## **Notice to all Dog Owners**

Pursuant to Section 174.052, Wisconsin Statues, notice is hereby given to all owners of dogs in Manitowoc County that rabies vaccinations and dog licenses are required under the statutes.

Vaccination by a veterinarian against rabies of all dogs is required within 30 days after the dog reaches 4 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. (There is no provision in the law for vaccination other than by a veterinarian.) Older vaccinated dogs must be revaccinated when the certificate expires or within 3 years of the previous vaccination.

CERTIFICATES OF CURRENT VACCINA-TION MUST BE PRESENTED WHEN OBTAIN-ING DOG LICENSES. ALSO PROOF OF NEU-TERING OR SPAYING-NO INVOICES.

Owners of all dogs 5 months of age or older on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year, shall annually on or before the date the dog becomes 5 months of age pay the dog license tax and obtain a license. The minimum

license fee for neutered males or spayed females is \$5.00 upon presentation of evidence attesting to the same, and \$10.00 for an unneutered male or unspayed female. Multiple dog licenses are \$35.00.

## **PENALTIES**

- 1. Also a late fee of \$5.00 SHALL be assessed the owner of each dog 5 months of age or over who fails to obtain a dog license by April 1 of each year.
- 2. An owner who fails to have a dog vaccinated against rabies as required by County Ordinance shall be punishable by a forfeiture not to exceed \$200.00.
- 3. The new dog license can be obtained from your local treasurer beginning January 2.
