4.02 Ordinance to temporarily lower speed limit on town highways.

Town of Cicero

The Town Board of the Town of Cicero, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under <u>s. 349.11</u>, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Cicero, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to reduce the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to $\underline{s.349.11}$, Wis. stats., effective October 15, 2007, speed limits on certain Town of Cicero, town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Grandy Road North of Highway F
- B. Pursuant to <u>s. 349.11 (5)</u>, Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under <u>s. 346.60</u>, Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on October 15, 2007

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under <u>s. 60.80</u>, Wis. stats.
