**ZONING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED**

Planning to make upgrades to your home this year? Looking at new siding, windows, or installing fence? What about adding on or building a storage shed? If any of these projects are in your summer plans, please remember that zoning permits are required for both commercial and residential improvements in the Village. Call the Village Office with questions before starting your projects and we'll be happy to help you through the quick and easy process!



**CONTAIN AND MANAGE  
YOUR CAMPFIRES!**

Campfires are permitted in the Village as long as they are contained in a campfire ring. Rings should not exceed 4 feet in diameter and must be extinguished by midnight.

**VILLAGE RESIDENTS, START YOUR ENGINES!**

Friendly reminder that all lawns, grasses and weeds on any parcel in the Village of Grantsburg must not exceed 8 inches in length. Refer to Village Ordinance 415-3. In addition, please do not blow grass clippings into the street to prevent them from washing down the stormwater drains. Refer to Village Ordinance 464-21 for more info.

**In-Person Absentee Voting:** Available Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays from **July 29 through August 7**, between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm at the Village Office.

**Voter Registration:** Online voter registration is available through July 22 for this election. You may also register in person at the Clerk's Office up to and including Election Day.

**Remember:** A valid photo ID is required to vote on Election Day and for in-person absentee voting.



**VILLAGE BRUSH SITE**

A key is needed to enter the site and can be checked out from the Village Office. Be mindful of construction activities and large equipment in the area. The brush site does not accept stumps or anything larger than 4inch in diameter.

**The Brush Site is available for Village Residents ONLY!**



**SPRINKLER METERS AVAILABLE**

Sprinkler meters are available at the Village Office for those wanting to take advantage of the sprinkler credit. Users will be charged a water usage fee for the water used, but will not be charged a sewer usage fee for the portion of water used for sprinkling. A \$5 fee plus a \$25 refundable deposit will be charged when picking up the sprinkler meter.
