HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE CURB CUT

The City of Oakley has approved a program to assist property owners with the placement of a handicapped accessible curb cut.

The City of Oakley will reimburse the property owner up to a maximum of \$350.00 for a handicapped accessible curb cut at the corner of a block. The following guidelines must be followed:

- 1) The City Office must be contacted PRIOR to the beginning of the work being done.
- 2) All trees which have caused damage to the present curb are to be removed before new curb is constructed.
- 3) The handicapped accessible curb cut must be according to ADA and ADAAG standards and meet the City's requirements to be eligible for rebate.
- 4) The property owner will also be eligible for the City's curb and gutter rebate and the City's sidewalk rebate program if sidewalk is removed or replaced or if new sidewalk is constructed along with the curb. (Separate forms for Curb and Gutter Improvement and Sidewalk Improvement).
