



CITY OF OAKLEY
SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Persons who are removing and replacing sidewalks which are parallel and adjacent or in line with existing sidewalk within the Oakley City limits are eligible for a reimbursement of \$4.00 per linear foot. Those persons who are installing new sidewalks which are parallel and adjacent or near to the City Street within the Oakley City limits are eligible for a reimbursement of \$2.50 per linear foot. The following guidelines must be followed.

- 1) The City Office must be contacted **PRIOR** to beginning of the removal of the sidewalk or in the case of new sidewalks **BEFORE** work begins in the construction of the sidewalk.
- 2) All trees which have caused damage to the present sidewalk will be required to be removed before a new sidewalk is constructed.
- 3) If possible, all sidewalks will be constructed adjacent to the curb. The sidewalks that are adjacent to the curb will be a minimum of 4 inches thick and 3 feet wide and the rebate will be prorated.
- 4) The sidewalks that are parallel to the curb will be a minimum of 4 inches thick and 4 feet wide. The width requirement may be waived due to space after contacting the City Office. If the sidewalk is less than 4 feet in width, the rebate will be prorated.
- 5) All of the City's requirements for concrete and sidewalk construction will be followed to be eligible for the rebate.
