**NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION ELECTION
CITY OF OAKLEY, KANSAS**

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the City of Oakley, Kansas (the “City”) that a special question election has been called and will be held on November 4, 2025, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City the following proposition:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall the City of Oakley, Kansas, be authorized, pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, to impose a one percent (1%) general purpose Citywide retailers’ sales tax (the “Sales Tax”), the revenues to be derived therefrom to be used for the purposes of: (1) assisting Unified School District No. 274, Logan County, Kansas (Oakley) (the “District”) in the repayment of a portion of the principal of and interest on general obligation bonds to be issued by the District in an amount not to exceed \$27,995,000 (the “District Bonds”) to pay the costs to construct, furnish and equip educational facilities and improvements in the District, and (2) provide for mill levy relief; provided that the collection of the Sales Tax shall commence on April 1, 2026, or as soon thereafter as permitted by law, and shall expire when all costs associated with the District projects, including the repayment of the District Bonds issued to finance or refinance such costs, shall have been paid; provided further that the imposition of such Sales Tax shall be subject to the following conditions: (i) approval by the electors of the City of this proposition; and (ii) approval by the electors of the District at an election to be held on November 4, 2025 of a proposition authorizing the issuance of the District Bonds?

To vote in favor of any question submitted on this ballot, press the word “Yes” on the voting machine or completely darken the oval to the left of the word “Yes” on the paper ballot. To vote against it, press the word “No” on the voting machine or completely darken the oval to the left of the word “No” on the paper ballot.

The election will be conducted by the officers and/or persons provided by law for holding elections, and the method of voting will be by ballot. Registered voters are eligible to vote by advance voting ballot upon application to the County Clerk at the address set forth below pursuant to K.S.A. 25-1117 *et seq.*

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The following additional information is provided by the City with respect to the effect of this ballot proposition. Passage of this ballot proposition would authorize the City to impose an additional one percent Citywide retailers' sales tax for the purposes described in the ballot question, so long as the election to be held on November 4, 2025 on the question of authorizing the District Bonds is also approved.

The election officer conducting the election will be the County Clerk of Logan County, Kansas, whose address is Logan County Courthouse, 710 West 2nd Street, Oakley, Kansas 67748.
