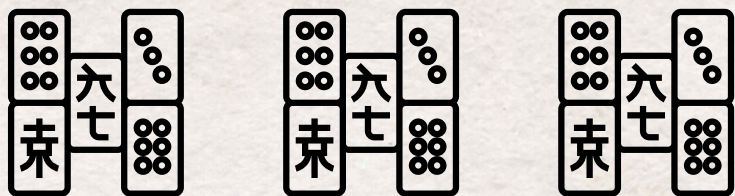

Toenail Clinic

Toenail Clinic is available to anyone wanting or
needing the service. Typically those who come to a
toenail clinic are having difficulty seeing or reaching
their feet, lack the grip strength needed to use a
clippers, are diabetic, or take medications such as
blood thinners that put them at risk of complications
if they do their own nails. The toenail clinic is
overseen by a Registered Nurse through Toenail
Trimmers, LLC. During the visit, feet will be medically
assessed, nails safely trimmed, callus care and nail
debridement if needed and finished with a
moisturizer. Care is recommended every 8-12 weeks.
The clinic is held at the Eagle Municipal Building. Cost
is \$35 for a 30 minute appointment.

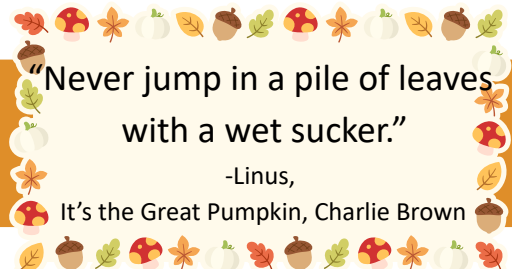

Easy 5-Ingredient Chili

Prep Time: 5 mins

Cook Time: 20 mins

Total Time: 25 mins

Servings: 6

Ingredients

1 pound lean ground beef

1 (15-ounce can) tomato sauce

1 (15 ounce) can kidney beans, drained

1 (15 ounce) can chili beans, not drained

2 tablespoons chili powder, or to taste

salt and freshly ground black pepper to taste

Directions

Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir ground beef in the hot skillet until browned and crumbly, 5 to 7 minutes.

Stir in kidney beans, chili beans, and tomato sauce. Bring to a boil and stir in chili powder. Reduce heat to a simmer, and cook, stirring occasionally, until thickened, about 15 minutes. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
