Animal Ordinance 101-8,9,10

No family shall keep in its possession more than three (3) dogs, two (2) cats, or Four (4) hens on any residential lot without the prior approval of the Village Board. Roosters or male fowl are prohibited.



#### THINGS TO NOTE FOR APRIL

- -Dog licensing is an annual requirement and is due by April 1st of every year. A \$5.00 late fee is applied after that date. The fine for an unregistered dog starts at \$187.00
- -The parking moratorium ends on April 1st.

In 1996 the property was purchased by local resident and business owner Joe Moos. The current occupant is Anchor Baptist Church which held its last service on February 28th of this year.
