Valentine's Day - February 14th

Also called Saint Valentine's Day or the Feast of Saint Valentine, originated as a Christian feast day honoring one or two Christian martyrs named Saint Valentine. Through later fold traditions, has become a significant cultural, religious, and commercial celebration of romance and love. There are a number of martyrdom stories associated with various Valentines connected to Feb 14th. The day became associated with romantic love in the 14th and 15th centuries when notions of courtly love flourished, by association with the "lovebirds" of early spring. In 18th century England, it grew into an occasion in which couples expressed their love for each other with flowers, confectionery and greeting cards (known as "valentines").

Groundhog Day – February 2nd

A popular North American tradition observed in the United States and Canada. It derives from the Pennsylvania Dutch superstition that if a groundhog emerges from its burrow on this day and sees its shadow due to clear weather, it will retreat to its den, and winter will go on for six more weeks; if it does not see its shadow because of cloudiness, spring will arrive early.
