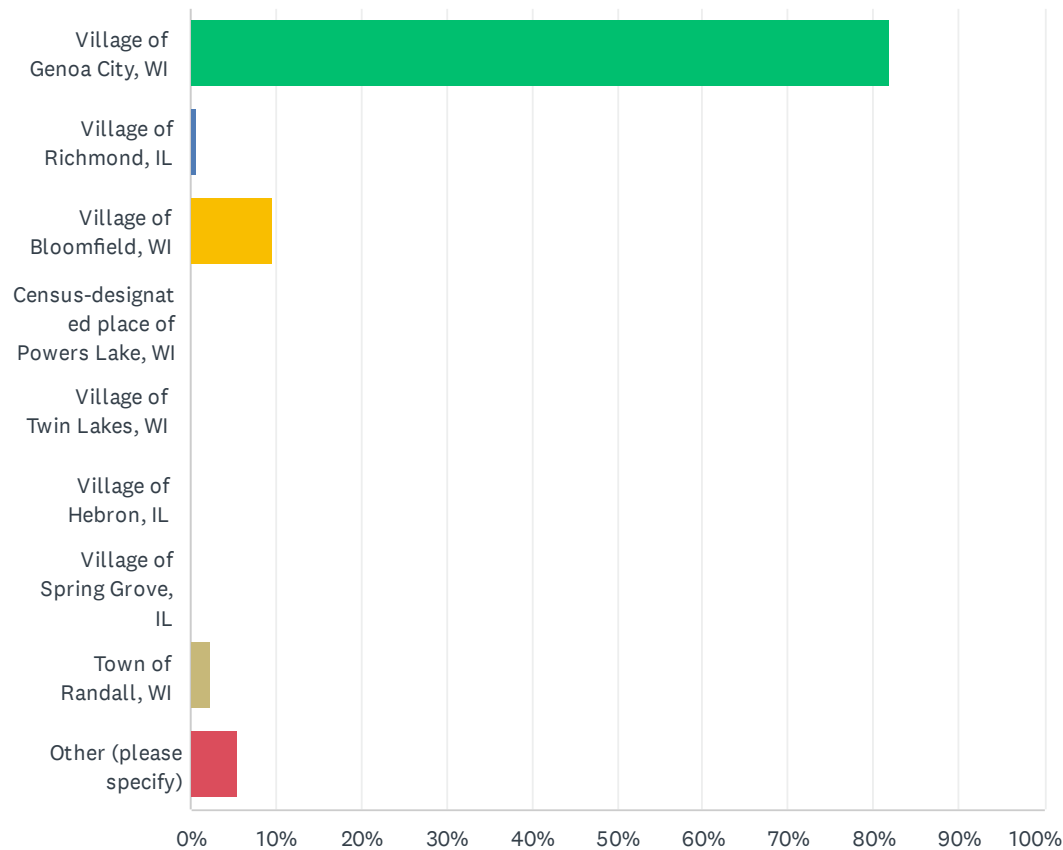

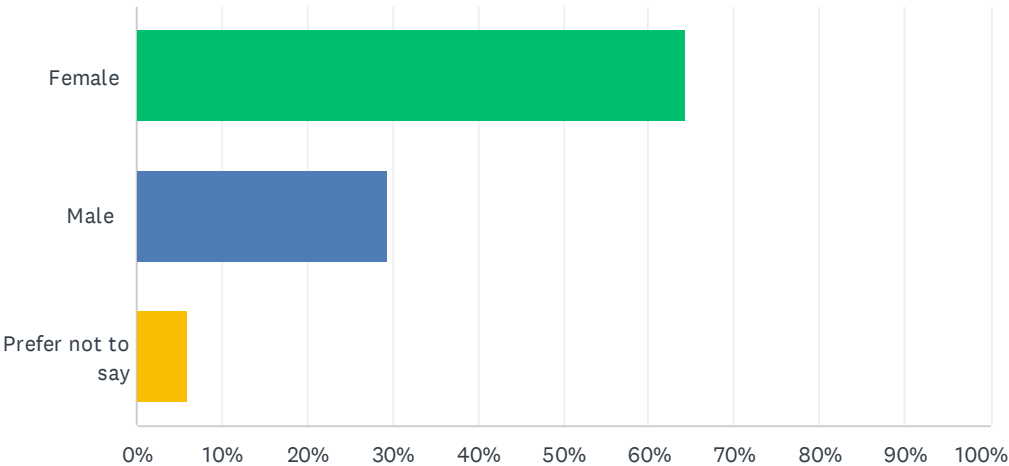

Q26 What is your gender?

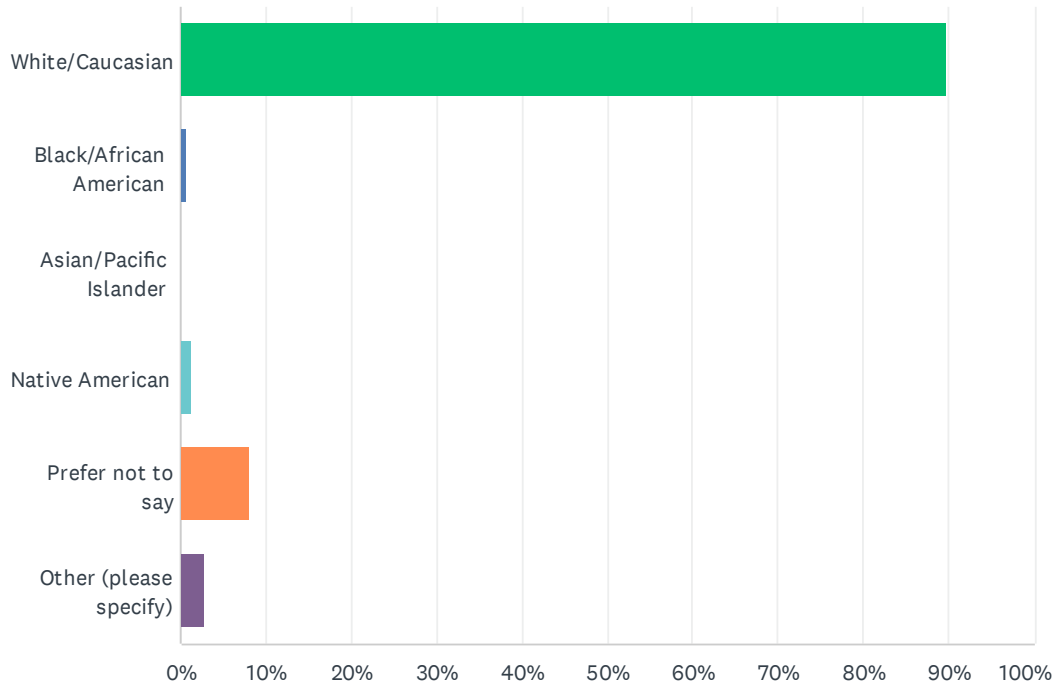

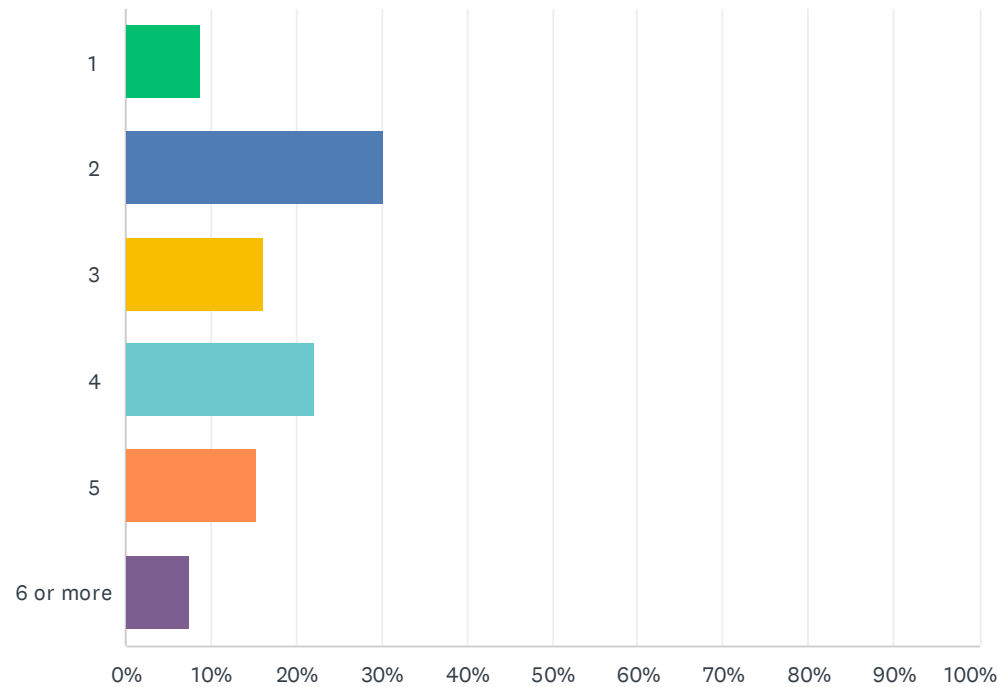

Q28 How many people live in your home, including yourself?

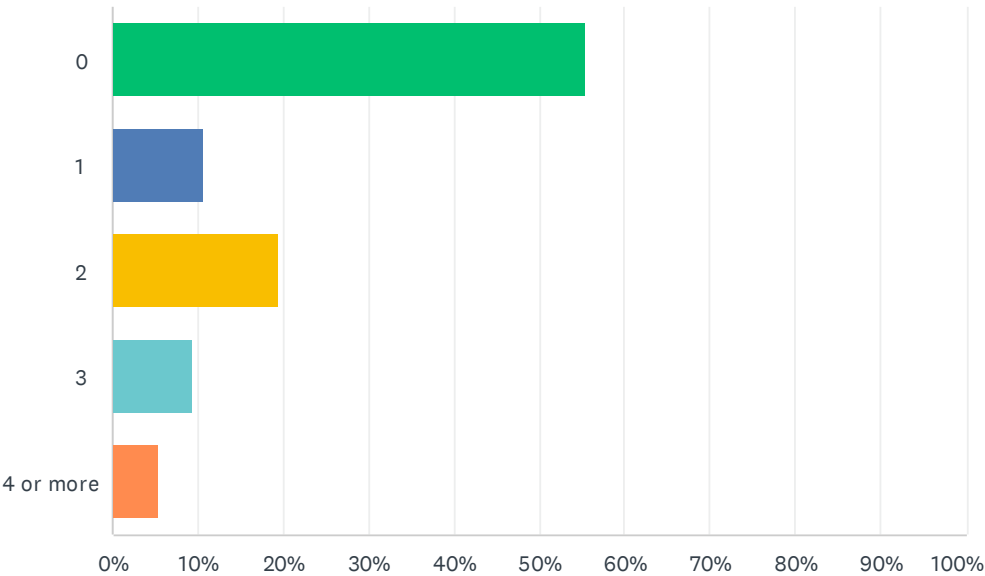

Q29 How many members of your household are under the age of 18?

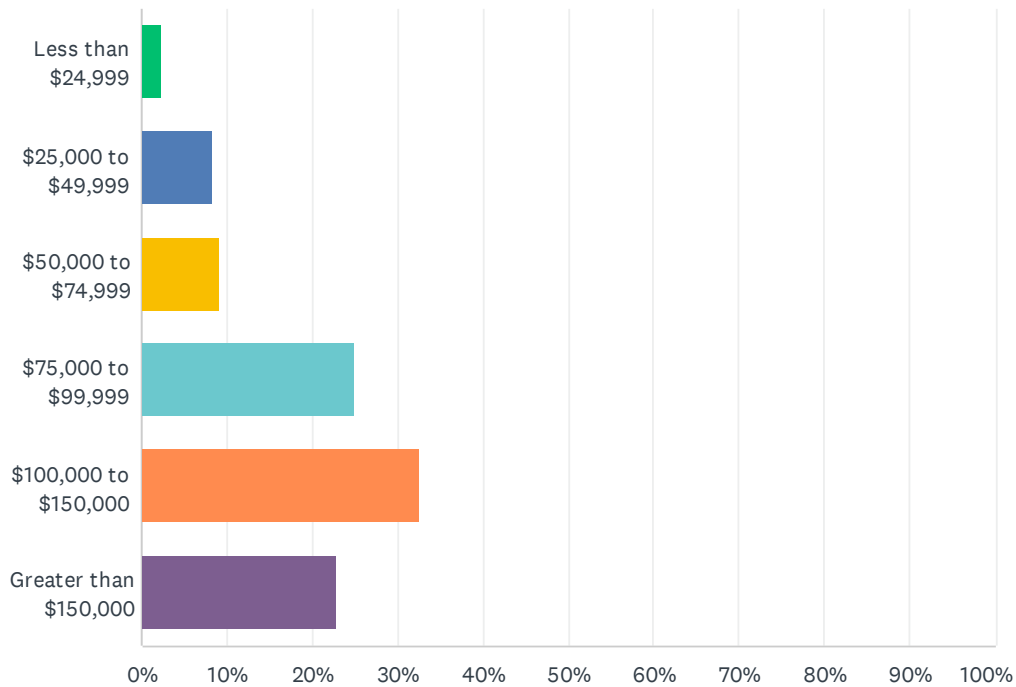
