


In December many of you filled out a survey and the response was outstanding! We received a 70% return rate (124 out of 177 residents). Enclosed in this report are the results and the planned next steps.

HOW IMPORTANT IS RELIABLE INTERNET?




Of the 124 surveys that were returned, 111 people completed this question. 93% of those surveyed stated reliable internet is: Very Important, Fairly Important, or Important.


HOW IMPORTANT IS FAST AND RELIABLE INTERNET?




Current Internet Providers



Although there are choices in our area for internet services, there are no Providers that offer high speed internet to all addresses. Only 17 addresses are utilizing HBC air.




WOULD YOU SIGN UP FOR HIGH SPEED FIBER OPTIC SERVICE?




The majority of township residents report they will sign up for high speed internet when available. Only 3% of those surveyed indicated they would not sign up for high speed fiber optic service.

The township is comprised of a broad mix of age groups all calling for high speed internet as it has become essential in our everyday lives regardless of age.

Paving the way for the future



There is a large number of respondents (80) that do not have any school age children. Without high speed internet, attracting families to the township of Cross is a major detraction.

Summary

- The response to the survey was outstanding 70% return rate thank you!
- The Township of Cross Board has motioned in support of the Committee taking the next steps.

- The information from the survey will be used for future steps:
 - Sharing with potential Providers of broadband offerings.
 - Obtaining quotes outlining development plans and costs.
 - Obtain funding and applying for grants.
- An overwhelming amount of residents define current state internet offerings as undesirable, it's simply too slow! Some examples from the Survey are as follows:
 - Students cannot stay connected to a virtual lesson plan, employed residents cannot efficiently work from home, streaming video is constantly paused if capable at all.
- There is currently only one Provider that offers high speed internet to our area (HBC), however, it is an air signal that can only be obtained if your residence is within line of sight of the HBC equipment. This only equates to 17 respondents. Again, there are no Providers that offer high speed internet to the majority of the town of Cross residents.
- The majority of residents would sign up with a Provider of high speed internet.
- The future state of high speed reliable internet has become a table stake and we must take the next steps to ensure the township of Cross has exhausted all avenues to obtain high speed internet services.
