If highway surface damage results from this project, the property owner (or contractor) shall notify the Town Office within 24 hours of such damage by telephone or in writing. All damage shall be corrected by the Township and associated costs shall be billed to the property owner. If the damage is not reported within 24 hours, the property owner (or contractor) shall be liable for treble costs, as allowed by State Statute 86.02.
