DOG LICENSES

NOTE: Licenses are only sold by your city, village or town treasurer

The State of Wisconsin requires that all owners purchase a license each year for all dogs over 5 months of age. Failure to license a dog could subject you to additional fines or fees. If you own rental properties or a mobile home park, you are required to inform your tenants of this law. If you are requesting a license by mail, submit a copy of the current rabies vaccination information provided by a licensed veterinarian, and be sure the following information is included on the rabies certificate:

- 1) Owner's name & address
- 2) Dog's name
- 3) Sex of dog & if it has been spayed or neutered.
- 4) Breed & color of dog
