ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS "B" HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF SIGEL PER §349.15 #2025-04

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Sigel Wood County

The Town Board of the Town of Sigel, Wood County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under \$349.15 (2), Wis. Stats, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by the majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Sigel are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in § 348.16 (2), Wis. Stats, unless increased by the town ordinance: ALL BLACK TOPPED ROADS IN THE TOWN OF SIGEL.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in § 348.16(2), Wis. Stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$250 nor more than \$2500, plus the applicable surcharge, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.
