Ordinance to Designate Class "B" Highways Town of Sharon Walworth County, State of Wisconsin Ordinance #2007-07-09

The Town Board of the Town of Sharon, Walworth County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15 (2) Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Sharon, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides the authority for the town to designate town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

the authority for the town to designate town highways as class "B" highways in the town as
follows:
A. The following town highways in the Town of Sharon are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2) Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance. Roads
B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21 Wis. Stats.
D. The Town may issue variance permits if deemed necessary.
This ordinance is effective on2007.
The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
