Trash and Recycling Collection Changes - Effective April 1, 2023

We are excited to confirm that the Village of Newburg has contracted with Harter's Lakeside Disposal for ongoing trash and recycling pick-up beginning April 1, 2023. Harter's is a family-owned, customer service-oriented Wisconsin company. Here are important details for you to know about this transition:

• **Mondays are the new pickup day, beginning April 1, 2023 with the first collection on Monday, April 3, 2023.**

• **You will receive new trash (black lid) and recycling (green lid) carts during the first week of April.** Place your "old / current" carts out for pickup by 6am Monday April 3rd. After your carts are emptied, they will be removed and replaced with new carts. Do not pull the emptied carts back to your house until replaced with the new carts. If you do not have a new cart by Wednesday, April 5, 2023, please contact Harter's at 920-552-5412.

• If you wish to keep your old cart for personal use (storage in the garage, gardening, etc..) that is permitted, BUT you may never put your old carts out for trash / recycling pickup. In case you wish to keep your old carts and not have them taken away during this transition week, please use duct tape and permanent marker to very clearly label your cart lid with "DO NOT TAKE OLD CART AWAY." You will still receive the new bins, but the old cart will be left for your personal use. Please note that if you move, you cannot take the NEW carts away with you – they stay with the home.

• **How to set out your carts:** Place your cart curbside before 6am on collection day, with the cart's handle facing your house and the lid opening toward the street. All solid waste (trash bin) must be bagged but recyclables should not be bagged. Be sure there is at least 4 feet between the carts and other objects such as the other cart or a mailbox. If your carts are set out late, please plan to wait until the next scheduled pick-up day. In the case of snow, if your cart will not fit in your driveway opening, then you will need to clean an opening in the snow bank – carts cannot be placed in the snowbank or in the road.

• If your trash and recycling does not fit in your cart, either save them for your next collection day or ask a neighbor if you can fill vacant space in their cart. You can also call Harter's to rent an additional cart for the year for a fee.

• Holiday collection will be delayed one day if the holiday is on a weekday before your pick-up day. See the calendar attached for details.

Effective April 1, 2023 the Village of Newburg will no longer be serviced by Waste Management and instead has contracted with Harter's Lakeside Disposal for Trash and Recycling Pick-up. We are confident that this new partnership will result in better and cost efficient service to the public. **Please note that your trash and recycling pick-up days are changing and will be on Mondays** going forward (pushed forward one day to Tuesdays on certain holiday weeks or during inclement weather). You will receive two new trash carts. The blue cart with BLACK lid is for trash and the blue cart with the GREEN lid is for Recycling. Place your cart curbside before 6am on the day of collection with the handle facing your house. Ensure at least 4 feet between cart and other objects. If cart is set out late, please wait for the next pickup. If cart is full, please ask neighbor if you can add trash to their cart.

Curbside Leaf Collection
 Curbside leaf collection begins October 1st and ends November 22nd. Piles should be out to the road Sunday night for the weekly routes that begin at 6am each Monday. Brush drop off accepted at the municipal lot until Nov. 22nd. If bagging leaves, paper bags are preferred. If using plastic, leaves can not be left in road.

E-Cycling: Electronics accepted.
 Drop off electronics to be disposed of such as computers, speakers, TVs, batteries.
