

Resolution 2013 - 16

## REQUEST THAT CHANGES BE MADE BY OZAUKEE COUNTY TO IMPROVE THE SAFETY OF THE STH 32-CTH V AND CTH W INTERSECTION NEAR THE I-43 INTERCHANGE

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes the importance of responsibility for providing and maintaining safe, convenient, and efficient roads that serve residents traveling to, from, and within the Town of Grafton and surrounding communities in Southeastern Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board agrees that the combination of motorist confusion, lack of signage or traffic signals, excessive travel speed along STH 32/CTH V, increasing volumes of "through" traffic along CTH W, truck traffic, and a higher percentage of turning vehicles, have all contributed to higher accident rates and unsafe travel conditions and increased numbers of severe accidents at this intersection; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board agrees that, as the collective body elected by the residents of the Town of Grafton, it needs to take actions and make decisions and/or recommendations on their behalf concerning local matters affecting town residents and property owners, including those issues and decisions made by other governments and agencies such as Ozaukee County; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board is concerned that the number of accidents will continue to increase, along with the severity and number of injuries at this intersection.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT: The Town of Grafton requests that changes be made by Ozaukee County to improve the safety of the STH 32-CTH V and CTH W intersection near the I-43 interchange.
