

Town of Grafton Ordinance No. 2016-02

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPLIT SHIFTS FOR ELECTION WORKERS

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing before the Town Board was duly published in the *Ozaukee Press* on January 21, 2016, and January 28, 2016; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held before the Town Board on February 10, 2016, regarding the proposed Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Grafton that the Ordinance be adopted as set forth below

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Grafton does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1:

The Town Board of the Town of Grafton, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance. This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 [or more] sets of officials to work at different times on each Election Day as follows:

There shall be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall typically commence at 6:30 a.m. and typically end at 1 p.m. The second shift shall typically commence at 1 p.m. and typically end with completion of all required Election Day duties that follow the closure of the polls.

Section 2:

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
