

TOWN OF GRAFTON EXAMPLE



- Culvert length is dictated by driveway width.
- The Town of Grafton requires each culvert to extend <u>one foot</u> beyond the edge of the driveway taper, which is typically <u>three feet</u>. (min 20 feet) (max 30 feet)
- Existing ditch grades must be maintained throughout and after construction.
- Both culverts shall have a minimum of 6" of aggregate base.



CULVERT LENGTH IS DICTATED BY DRIVEWAY WIDTH.

THE TOWN OF GRAFTON REQUIRES EACH CULVERT TO EXTEND <u>ONE FOOT</u> BEYOND THE EDGE OF THE DRIVEWAY TAPER, WHICH IS TYPICALLY <u>THREE FEET</u>. (MIN 30 FEET) EXISTING DITCH GRADES MUST BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT AND AFTER CONSTRUCTION.

BOTH CULVERTS SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM OF 6" OF AGGREGATE BASE.
