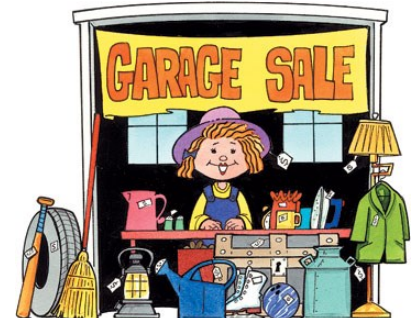

Because it was a redesign we have experienced some delays in getting equipment and believe it or not COVID also is still impacting some of the suppliers. One issue that is a constant complaint of residents is the Public Nuisance Ordinance regarding the looks of property throughout the Village. Please be diligent in taking care of your property, making sure that the grass is mowed on a regular basis and there is no unsightly debris laying around. It may not be an issue for the property owner, but it causes problems for neighbors and does not give a positive image for visitors to our small community. The Cascade Police Department will work with your Village Board to identify and address nuisance related issues throughout the Village. Also under the nuisance ordinance is unlicensed / junk vehicles, please remember that every vehicle on a property needs to have a current registration unless it is covered under an exemption to the ordinance.
