Dear Town of Iola Resident:

In accordance with Chapter 174.05 and 174.07 of the Wisconsin statutes, rabies vaccinations are required for all dogs 4 months or older, and licenses are required for all dogs 5 months or older. The Town of Iola is the government body that is responsible for issuing dog licenses and checking on rabies vaccination compliance.

Dog Licensing Procedures: You must obtain a dog license annually through the Town of Iola treasurer. You can do this by submitting the required form attached below. Proof of rabies vaccination will be required with this application. Licenses for the entire year are issued from January 1st through March 31st of each year.

Dog Licensing Fees & Penalties: The fee for dog license is \$10 with a \$5 discount if the dog has been spayed or neutered. A late fee of \$5 will be assessed an owner who fails to obtain a dog license before April 1st. An owner who fails to have a dog vaccinated against rabies may be required to forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$100.
