ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE TO RAISE THE LATE FEE ON THE COLLECTION OF DOG LICENSES PAID AFTER APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR

The Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, by this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and ordains as follows:

Pursuant to s. 174.05 (5). Wis. stats., the collecting official shall assess and collect a late fee of \$25 from every owner of a dog 5 months of age or over, if the owner failed to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year, or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or if the owner failed to obtain a license on or before the dog reached licensable age.

This ordinance supersedes any fee structure on the collection of a late fee for failure to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year. This ordinance shall take effect on November 1, 2022.
