|    | Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, office paper, paperback books & cereal boxes                    | Paper must be clean, dry, & placed in a brown paper bag or bundled.                   | Soiled or wet paper, carbon paper, papers coated with foil, wax, glitter, or glue. Construction paper, wrapping paper, & hardback books (unless covers & are binding completely removed). |
|    | Brown, white & gray corrugated cardboard..   | Cardboard must be clean & dry then flattened & placed in a bag, box, or bundled.      | Soiled or wet cardboard (i.e. NO pizza boxes) Cardboard coated with wax, tin, or plastic  |
|    | Tin, steel aluminum, bimetal containers, foils, tins, coated cans, & totally empty aerosol cans. | Empty & rinse well. If possible, remove labels.                                       | Full or partially full containers, aerosol cans still containing product.   |
|   | #1 & #2 BOTTLE shaped containers. Cardboard beverage & food containers                           | Empty, rinse well, & remove caps. If possible, remove labels.                         | All plastic #3 through #7 or unnumbered #1 & #2 containers not shaped like a bottle, plastic bags, wraps, any motor oil, cooking oil bottles and pesticide containers.                    |
|  | Clear, green, & brown containers   | Empty, rinse well, & separate by color, remove lids, caps, remove labels if possible. | Window glass, light bulbs, ceramics, porcelain, clay items, drinking glasses, ovenware, & dishes.   |
