Permanent Piers and Structures within Waterways:

Are you looking at pursuing the purchase and installment of a permanent pier or a new pier configuration on your shoreland property? Before diving into the purchase process, please take a moment to read the following documents to make sure whatever type of configuration you are planning to implement, is following DNR standards. (WI DNR Pier Planner) (WI DNR Pier Exemption Checklist)

If you have further questions on the guidelines of these documents, please consider contacting the regional DNR Water Management Specialist to discuss the process. This can help avoid potential violations, fees, and penalties for not following the set state standards for piers and structures within waterways.
